

Grade Reporting

Report cards are sent home with the students at the end of each quarter. Teachers are required to notify parents before the end of the grading period if a student is making a grade lower than "C". Parents are encouraged to visit with teachers throughout the school year so that they are in the know of what their children are doing in their classes.

All academic grading in Pioneer Christian School uses a criterion-referenced base for evaluation. (The student's work will be evaluated against an objective standard in each class). Grade point averages (G.P.A.s) are computed at the end of each quarter. Only semester grades appear on the student's high-school transcript. The following percentages, grades, and grade points are used for Pioneer Christian School.
